

## First Cycle of Accreditation of FETPs 2015-2016.

The TEPHINET Global ACCREDITING BODY (GAB) awarded three accreditations as part of the First Cycle of Accreditation of FETPs 2015-2016. Two of the accredited programs are national FETPs, and the third includes four countries. Following these accreditation decisions the populations of 6 countries and more than 400 million people are served by FETPs that align their programs, and might generously exceed, with the Accreditation of FETPs Minimum Indicators and Standards for delivering quality training of field epidemiologist and delivery of public health services to their communities
